Johnson - Funeral services for Elbert Harvey Jenkins (1860-1947), pioneer Ocala resident, who died at his home here Tuesday, following an extended period of failing health, were held Thursday afternoon at the Johnson Cemetery, with W. Carl Davis and Son in charge.

Mr. Jenkins was born in Newark, Vt., in 1860, and came to Florida about sixty years ago. For many years he was superintendent of the big Edgar Kaolin plant. He had long been active in the Presbyterian Church, serving many years as an elder.

He is survived by his wife, Mrs. Maggie N. Jenkins; one son Charles W. Jenkins, of Johnson, and one daughter, Mrs. Archie E. Neck of Palatka, and three grandchildren.
