

Mock, Mabel

Johnson, 3 Oct - On Friday of last week, the funeral of little Mabel, the two-year-old child of Mr. and Mrs. Grady Mock, was held here, and the remains were interred in the church cemetery.

The sad accident came as a great surprise. The little one met death by scalding. The mother was preparing to do some work in the household, bringing in a pail of boiling water. As she came in the child was playing in the yard, running in the house, playing and ran backwards and fell in a sitting position in the pail of hot water. The result was that the vital organs were paralyzed by the heat and now what was a moment ago a happy, playful child was a pitiable sight.

The accident happened on Thursday afternoon, death resulting in a few hours. Being the only child in the home, it leaves a double aching void in the hearts of its parents, which time alone can fill.
