Willard Jay Arme y

Dr. Willard Jay Arme y, 85, of Interlachen, went to Glory peacefully in his sleep Tuesday, Aug. 7, 2007, after an extended illness at his residence.

Willard was born Oct. 2, 1921, in Silver Lake, Ind., to the late Benjamin H. and Anna L. Arme y. Willard served his country proudly in the U.S. Army Airborne during WWII in Europe and Germany. Mr. Arme y received his doctorate at O'Neil College of Chiropractic and was an ordained minister of the Gospel through the Anderson, Ind., Church of God. He served as a pastor and chiropractor for more than 20 years before retiring and moving to Florida. Willard also worked for the Sunland State Home as a cabinetmaker until his retirement in 1994. He was dedicated to his Lord and his family, and served as an elder and organist at the Florahome Church of God until his illness. Willard loved music, family and fellowship and was an avid woodworker.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Benjamin and Anna Arme y; his wife Glenna Evangeline Arme y; four brothers, Donald, Paul, Rex and Lawrence; a sister, Emma Shepler; and two children, Diana Kenney and Terrence Arme y.

Willard is survived by his sister, Betty Olsen; two brothers, Bobby and Denny Arme y; two sons, Jack and Peter Arme y; two daughters, Jill Powell and Jaye Arme y, along with their spouses, Linda Arme y, Belinda Arme y and Danny Powell; and numerous grandchildren and great-grandchildren.

A service will be held at 11 a.m. Saturday, Aug. 18, at the Florahome Church of God in Florahome to celebrate Willard's triumphant victory of faith. The Rev. Tim Haunstein and the Rev.
