## Johnson, Daniel Webster

Daniel Webster Johnson, aged resident of West Putnam County passed away at his home in Johnson on September 11 in the early morning hours.

Mr. Johnson was one of the leading citizens and merchants of this section for many years, and his passing is marked by the deep regrets of his friends.

He had been confined to his bed for months past following his steady failing in health for several years, and so the end came as no surprise.

Mr. Johnson is survived by his widow and eight children - five sons and three daughters, all of whom are married and have families, and are living in Florida, except one whose home is in South Carolina.

The funeral was held from the Johnson Church at 4 o'clock Sunday afternoon, the impressive services being conducted by Dr. Donald MacQueen, pastor of the First Presbyterian Church of Palatka. Scores of friends from all sections of the county were in attendance to pay their last tribute of respect and esteem.

The presence of a large number of colored people bore evidence of the general sorrow of the community over the passing of the pioneer citizen.
